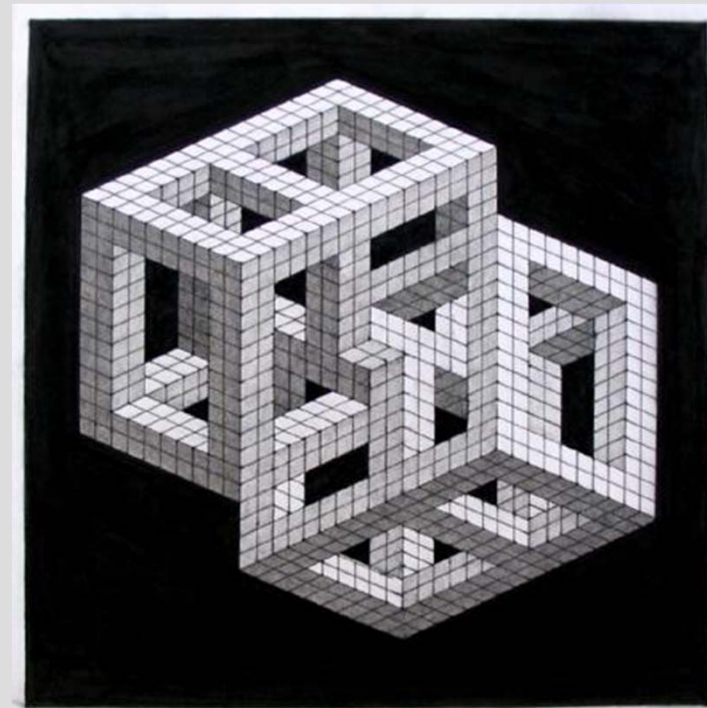
- Paradigm, paradigm shift

Paradigm



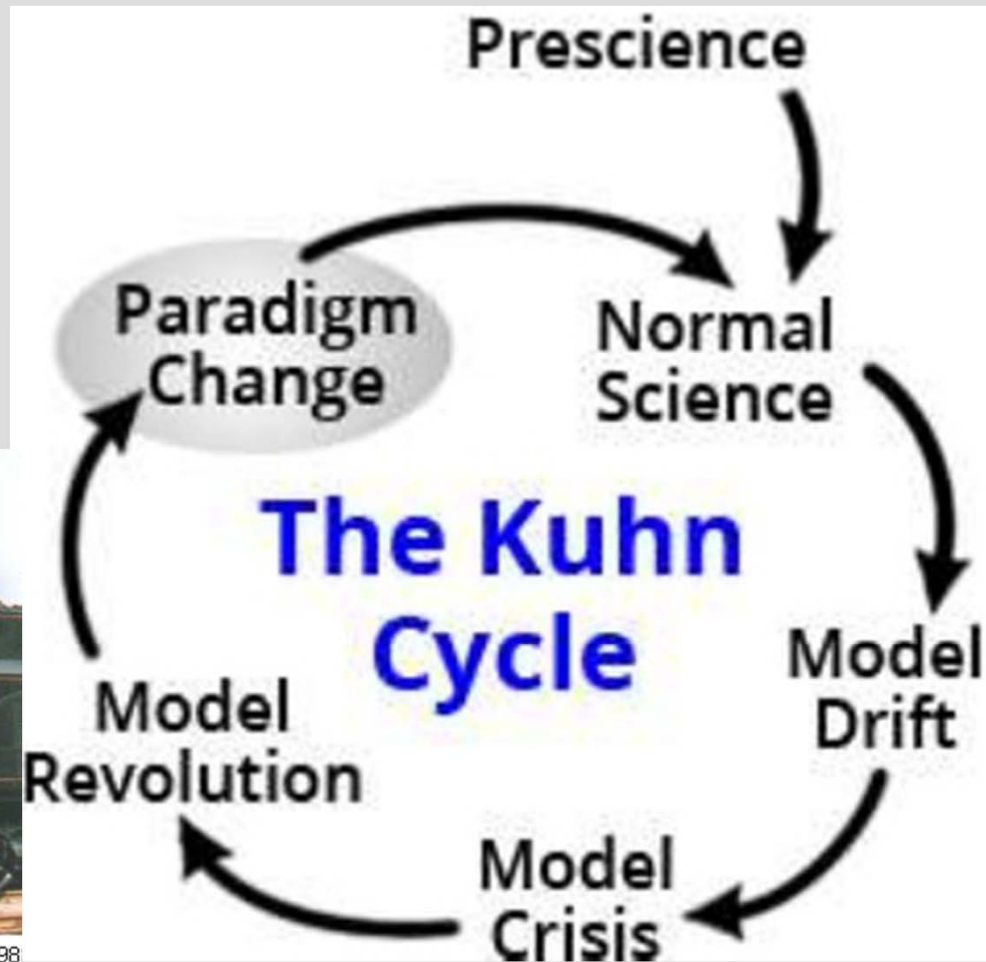
Paradigm

- literacy became most important

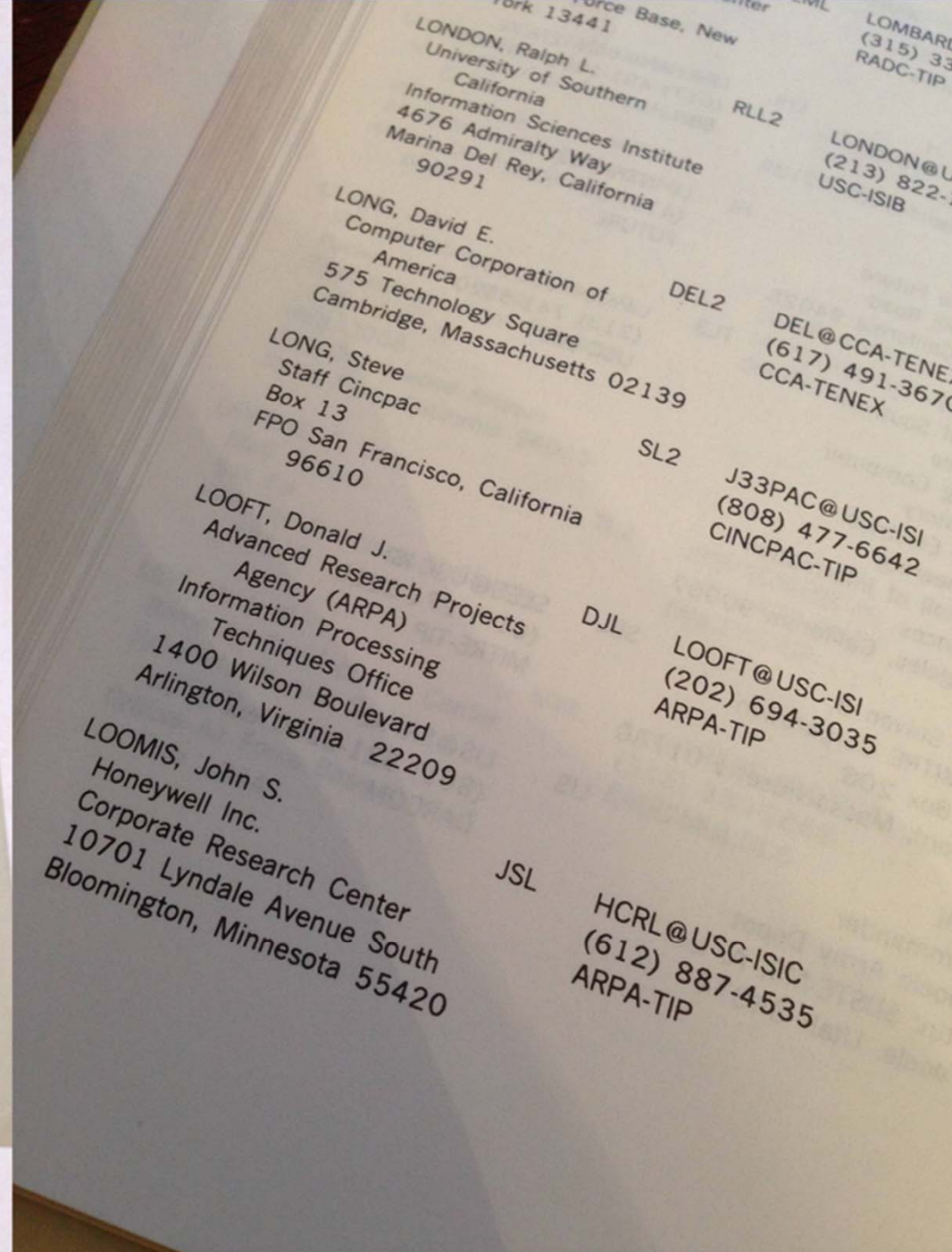
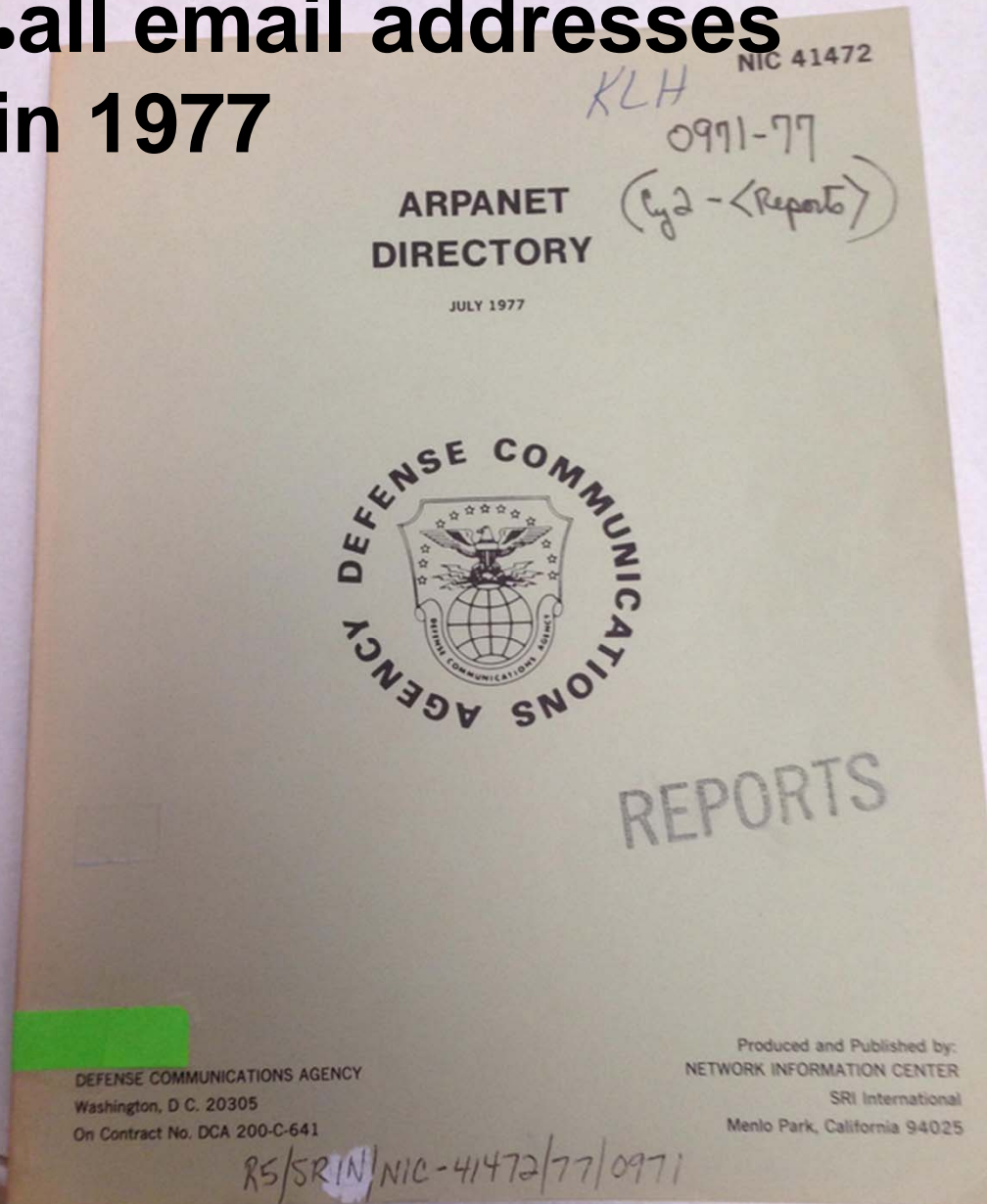

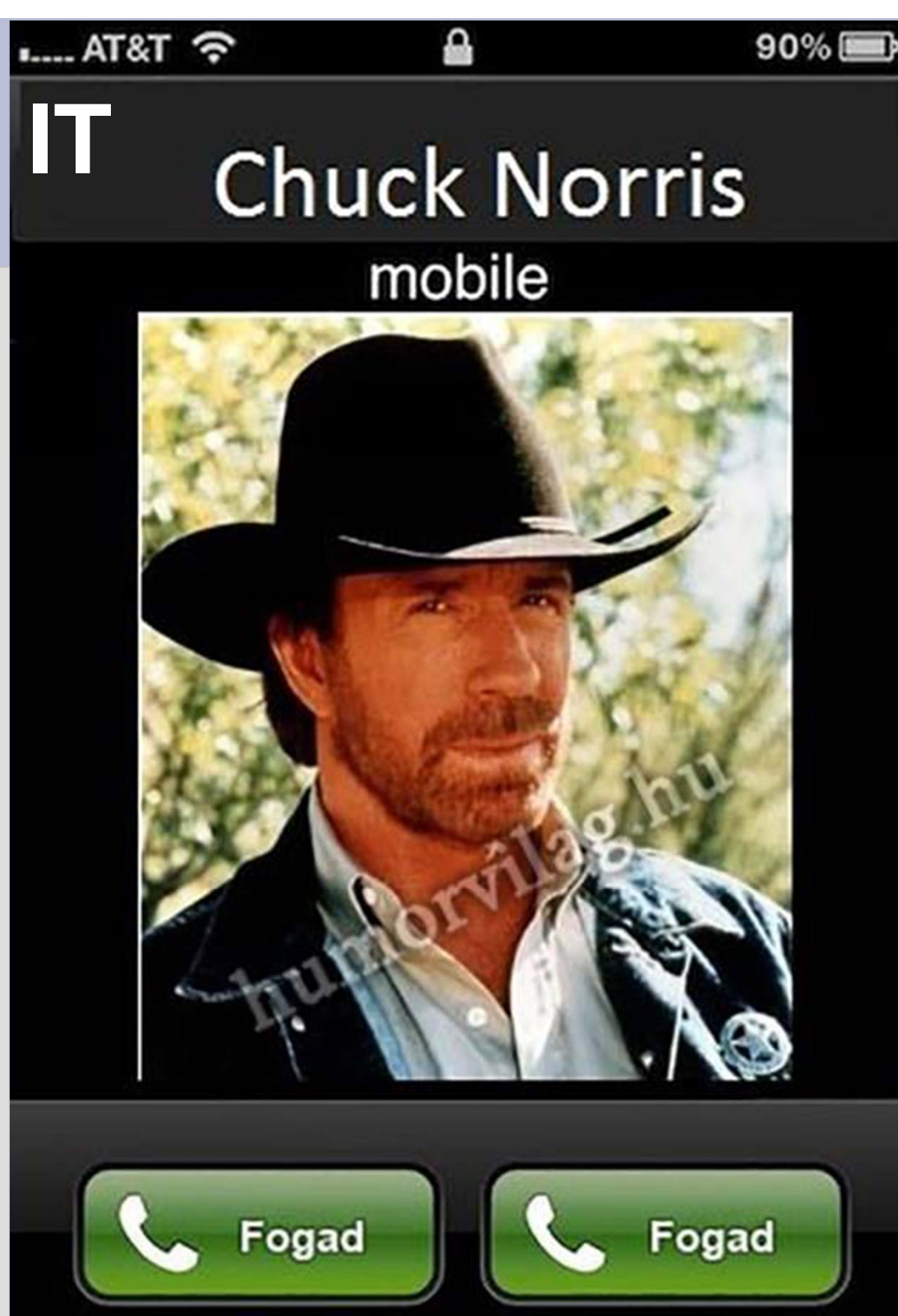

Consequences

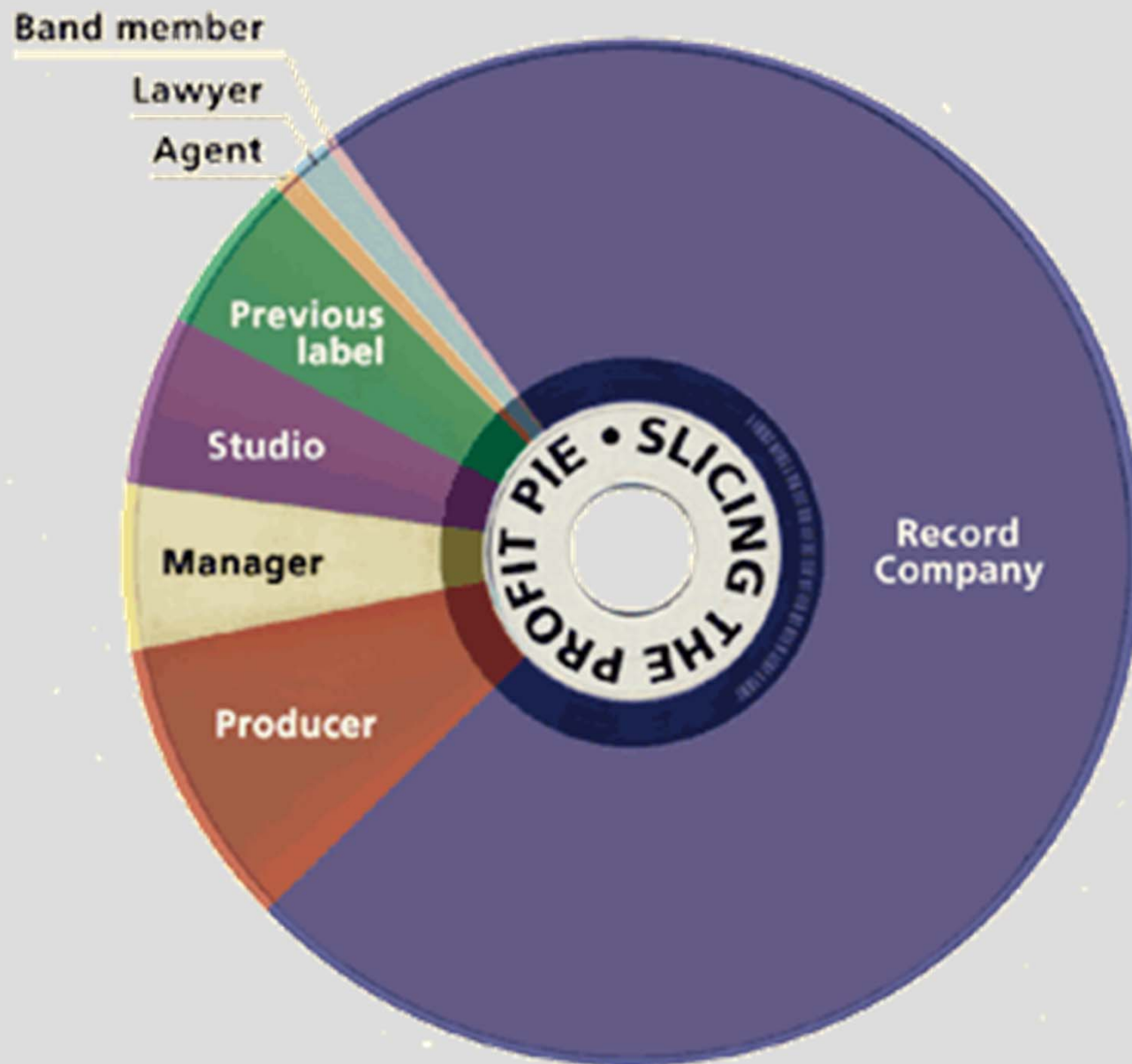
- DIGITAL NETWORK endpoints everywhere

Ethics

- universal and general rules of life
- natural moral rules (lex moralis naturalis):
inner motivation
 - to do the good
 - to avoid the bad
- examples
 - defense of life,
 - defense of justice,
 - defense of private property, etc.

Ethics

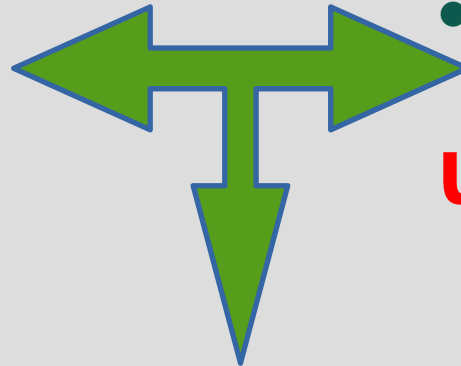
- objective rules (see prev. slide)

Written and unwritten rules

- formal law vs. ethical/moral rules
- “Unwritten rules do exist and those people, who sometimes make written rules a little bit softer, must strictly keep them.” (Rejtő)

Written and unwritten rules

- Consciousness is always before written law!
- Official law is stronger than you.

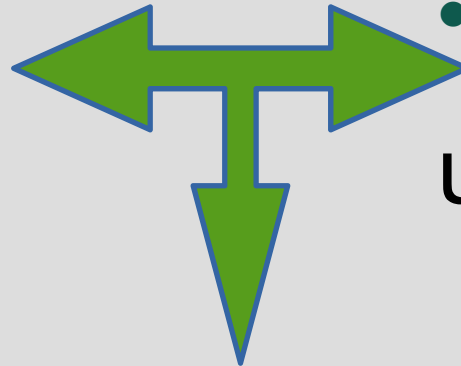

Copyright, music

- case of Capitol Records v. Thomas-Rasset
 - 1.500.000 USD for sharing 12 songs
- Is it real and normal?
- Can the whole society be criminalized?
(when anyone can up-/download music)

Copyright, movie

- (Bodó, Lakatos, 2010):
 $\frac{3}{4}$ of torrentable movies were **not** available in cinemas
- How many cinemas in Bor? In Belgrade?
- How many movies do exist?
- Is it true that one download means one less cinema ticket?
- Can the whole society be criminalized?
(when anyone can up-/download music)

Copyright, books

- What if the book cannot be bought in paper?
- Should they be lost forever for the new generations?

Copyright, software

- Developer is not responsible for anything?
- If you wanted to test a software before buying it?
- If a student wanted to try out a particular sw?

Copyright

- Is downloading good for the society itself?
- ...for the bands and film studios?
- May free file-sharing make greater benefit...
 - ...for the whole society than the losses of the industry?
 - ...even for the industry itself?

Content filtering / censorship

- Should parents decide what content their children may (must not) access?
- What if school rules differ from home rules?

Content filtering / censorship

- Internet usage of employees at an enterprise?
- What in case of BYOD, official and private usage cannot be strictly distinguished?

- Great Firewall of China?

Content filtering / censorship

- Technical problems:
 - xxx: aic78xxx SCSI driver,
 - babes: Babes-Bolyai University, etc.
 - photo/audio/movie filtering...

Freedom of speech, anonymity

- Should ISP give user data to police?
- Lavabit case (Snowden)
- Difference between private conversation and publication?
 - Shared (and further shared) posts on FB?

Whistleblowing

- Is an Edward Snowden a terrorist or a hero?

Online life and privacy

- Should, e.g., a FB profile be part of the heritage?
- What to do with accounts of dead people?
- Charity workers posed as a (fake) 10 year „old” Filipina girl – a supposed-to-be pedophile guy was convicted.
- What law(s) must be applied when:
 - service provider in one country,
 - data center in another,
 - user is citizen of a third...?

- Even in case of SSL encryption used by netbanking (too)?

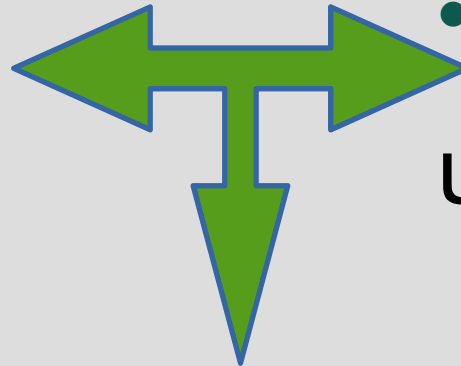
